



# SUMMER SERIES 2018

## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats with RYA Portsmouth Yardstick Handicap ratings.
- 2.2. Entrants must be club members.

### 3. SCHEDULE

- 3.1. Each Sunday from 10<sup>th</sup> June to 19<sup>th</sup> August 2018
- 3.2. Number of races: There will be up to three races per day.
- 3.3. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of the AM series is 1100.
- 3.4. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of the PM series is 1300.
- 3.5. The morning races will be sailed as the Spring AM Series, the afternoon races as the Spring PM Series, scored separately.

### 4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1. The 2018 Sailing Instructions, as posted in the Clubhouse will apply.
- 4.2. Supplementary sailing instructions will be posted on the official notice board.

### 5. THE COURSES

- 5.1. The courses to be sailed will be as directed by the Race Officer on the day, as posted on the course board next to the Race Hut.
- 5.2. In the absence of a Race Officer, and if conditions permit, racing will be conducted from the safety boat.
- 5.3. At the Race Officer's discretion, a separate start may be employed for Junior sailors.

### 6. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 6.1. Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

### 7. SCORING

- 7.1. Scoring will be the low score system, as detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

### 8. PRIZES

- 8.1. Trophies will be awarded to the series winners of morning and afternoon races

### 9. SAFETY CONDITIONS

- 9.1. In colder weather, all participants must wear suitable clothing, plus buoyancy aid.
