

### **Name, Address**

These are the details required for the main member.

Please complete this section for all family members to be included in your membership.

Date of birth is optional for those over 16 years, but it helps us to understand our membership better if you can provide that information.

### **Email address and telephone numbers**

We communicate with our members primarily via email so please let us know your email address. We will also subscribe this email address to the website for automatic notices. If your family members have their own email address, please include these as well.

We do not distribute your details to any other body or person. Under the new GDPR regulations which came into force in May 2018, we need your permission to hold your contact details. However, if you wish your telephone number or email address to be withheld from other members, please let us know.

### **Craft**

Please enter details of all craft to be sailed at Durleigh, including those for which you do not require a boat space.

All craft must have third party liability insurance of at least £1,000,000. Please confirm your insurance details for each boat.

### **Membership Type**

Please indicate the membership type you require (see Subscriptions for details).

Family members can include your spouse/partner and dependants under the age of 16 years and/or in full time education.

Please advise if a boat park space is required.

Any road trailers not stored under your boat will require a trailer licence.

Each craft will require a sailing licence.

Single members with more than one boat may request additional free of charge sailing licences if they confirm in writing that they will not have more than one craft on the water at any time. *This does not apply to the Junior Package.*

An additional sailing licence is required for additional family boats on family memberships, not for boats sailed as single handers.

Windsurfers need only purchase sailing licences for the maximum number of boards that they will have on the water at any one time. Please state how many you require.

Single Junior membership is for juniors under sixteen and Students in full time education.

The Single Junior Package is issued on the understanding that they will be the sole helm of the dinghy. Boat space and sailing licence is included in the package.

### **Duties**

Every member of DSC is required to assist with the running of the club by doing sailing duties.

There are four types of duties:

Race Officer/Officer of the Day (RO/OOD) – you are responsible for the running of races and sailing for the day, supported by:

Safety Boat Officer (SBO) – you must hold an RYA Powerboat 2 qualification or greater.

Assistant Safety Boat Officer (ASBO) – you must be physically fit and able to assist the SBO – no qualifications required.

Galley Officer (Assistant race officer) – you are responsible for providing refreshments in the clubhouse. On occasions you may be asked to help the race officer which is entirely voluntary and can help if you wish to familiarise yourself with what race officer entails. .

Details of each duty are available in the club handbook. Training is available.

Please ensure you provide an email address for each nominated duty member.

Please confirm any relevant training qualifications.

Please confirm if you wish to be included in our list of members who are willing to cover another member's duty for a fee. Some members are willing to pay someone else to do their duty. This is a private arrangement between members, but we can facilitate such swaps.

For renewals, we will assume all members will be renewing their membership for the new season. Unless we hear, in writing, to the contrary you will be sent an allocation email from the Rota Secretary at the beginning of January giving you the option of selecting your duties for the season. This will be on a "first come – first served" basis and available for approximately one month. After this 'allocation' period, the Rota Secretary will fill free slots with those members who have failed to select their duties.

To keep fees to a minimum, each member is required to do two full day duties a year. Sundays count as one duty and Wednesday evenings and Saturday afternoons are half a duty. At least two members of a family membership are expected to do two full duties each. However, non-sailing family members are exempt from duties.

We do have a 'duty opt out' fee. If you wish to opt out completely, we will use the fee to pay someone else.

The Icicle and Winter series do not form part of the duty year, as above and those taking part will arrange the duties amongst themselves.

### Declaration

Please read and understand the declaration.

In particular, please note that every craft, anywhere on the premises, must have third party liability insurance of at least £1,000,000. We will need the insurance details for each one.

The club constitution is available in the club handbook and on the website.

### MEMBERSHIP

Individual adults	£47.00
Family (defined as two co-habiting adults together with their children under 16 years old or over that age if in full time education.)	£52.00
Juniors (less than 16 years) and students (in full time education)	£26.00
Junior Package - includes membership, sailing licence and boat space	£47.00

Group membership is negotiable on an individual basis dependent on the use of club facilities.

### SAILING LICENCE

Every boat in the dinghy park or on the water must display a sailing licence disc (except temporary members for the day).

Single boat/windsurfing board	£42.00
Additional boats/windsurfing boards designated for use by family members nominated in family membership.	£11.00

An individual sailor or windsurfer who keeps a second boat/board for their own personal use (e.g. to suit varying wind conditions) may apply in writing to the Membership Secretary for a second disc at no charge by affirming that both boats/boards will be used only by himself.
